West Virginians have two weeks left to apply for FEMA Assistance

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Renters and homeowners in Marion and Ohio counties who were affected by the June 14-15 storms have two weeks to apply for FEMA assistance. **The last day to apply is Monday, Sept. 22.**

You should also file an insurance claim. If you have homeowners, renters, or flood insurance, you should file a claim before applying for FEMA assistance. FEMA cannot duplicate benefits for losses covered by insurance. If your policy does not cover all your disaster expenses, you may be eligible for federal assistance.

While your claim is processing, FEMA assistance may be able to help with uninsured losses. This can include help if you are displaced, need temporary lodging, require basic home repair costs, or lose personal property. **The fastest way to apply is online at DisasterAssistance.gov.**
