Ohio County, W.Va., Disaster Recovery Center will Close Permanently after Sept. 19, 2025

CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The state-led Disaster Recovery Center at the Triadelphia Community Center in Ohio County will close permanently on Friday, Sept. 19, at 5 p.m. The deadline for individuals and families to apply for FEMA assistance is **Monday, Sept. 22.**



If you have questions about your disaster recovery, you can still receive help.

The West Virginia Emergency Management Division will continue to [post disaster updates online](#).

You can go to DisasterAssistance.gov to track the status of your FEMA application online. If you need help, you can call the FEMA helpline at 800-621-3362. If you use video relay service, captioned telephone service or others, give FEMA your number for that service.

Applying for FEMA assistance is an ongoing process. Submitting a FEMA application is only one step. FEMA may try to get in touch with you from an unknown number. You could receive a letter from FEMA letting you know that your application has missing or incomplete information. Read all letters from FEMA carefully. And if you disagree with FEMA's decision, [you can appeal](#) within 60 days of the date on your FEMA letter.
