ABOUT THE STANDARD RESPONSE PROTOCOL DETAILS AND STANDARD REUNIFICATION METHOD: The Standard Response Protocol (SRP) and Standard Reunification Method (SRM) are used for crisis response and post-crisis reunification in

more than 45,000 schools, districts, departments, agencies, organizations and communities around the world.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR: The Full Day Train the Trainer Workshop introduces participants to the history, concepts and functionality of the SRP and SRM and how to train the programs internally. Participants will walk away from the workshop with a deep understanding of how the SRP provides a proven, action-based enhancement to all hazards school safety planning. After learning about the five actions of the SRP, and their associated directives, participants will be able to implement the program and enhance the safety plans of their school/ district.
