FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

MAY 20, 2021

On May 20, 2021, President Joseph R. Biden Jr. granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of West Virginia triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Severe Storms and Flooding that occurred February 27 to March 4, 2021. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Incident:	Severe Storms and Flooding
Incident Period:	February 27 to March 4, 2021
Federal Coordinating Officer:	Jeffrey L. Jones National FCO Program
Individual Assistance (IA):	(Assistance to individuals and households):
IA-Designated Counties:	Cabell, Kanawha, Mingo, and Wayne Counties.
Public Assistance (PA):	(Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
PA-Designated Counties:	Boone, Kanawha, Lincoln, Logan, Mingo, and Wayne Counties.

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of West Virginia are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further assessments.
