Develops and supports processes to minimize any possibility of waste, fraud, and abuse. May support overall assessment activities of various federal grant programs, including compliance with federal performance measures. Thorough knowledge of 2 CFR 200 is necessary for successful performance of this position. Complex accounting, internal and external auditing.
