Enclosed is the After Action Report/Improvement Plan for the Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS) Plume Exercise for the State of West Virginia that was held on June 14, 2016.

There were no Level 1 Findings, two (2) Level 2 Findings, and one (1) Planning Issue identified during the exercise. Also, there were no outstanding Performance or Planning Issues from previous exercises.

The Level 2 Finding; Issue No: 03-16-5.b.1-L2-01 will be re-demonstrated on November 10, 2016 during the Beaver Valley Power Station Mini Drill. The Planning issue that was identified was corrected on August 29, 2016.

Based on the results of the exercise and a review of the offsite radiological emergency response plans and procedures submitted, FEMA Region III has determined they are adequate (meet the planning and preparedness standards of NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Revision 1, November 1980, as referenced in 44 CFR 350.5) and there is reasonable assurance they can be implemented, as demonstrated during this exercise.
